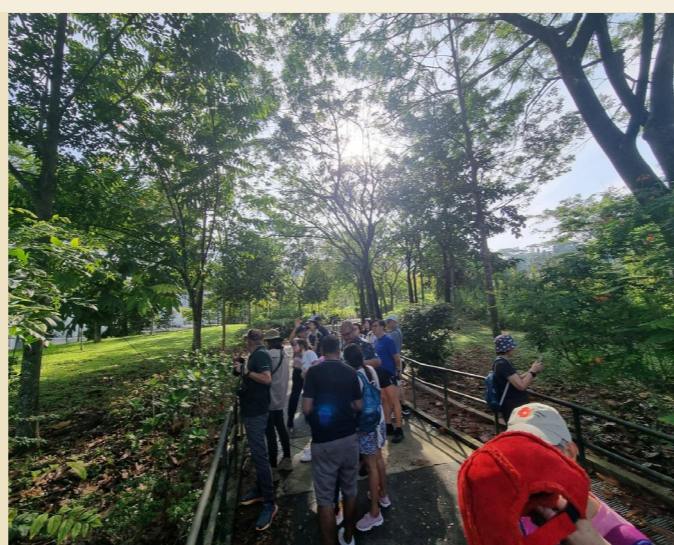


Tree Planting

In line with the OneMillionTrees movement, Nature Kakis chapters can assist or co-facilitate community-led tree planting events within housing estates for residents in their constituency.

Nature Walks

Immerse in the flora and fauna of our parks and gardens by participating in, assisting or conducting guided walks for residents in their constituency.



Nature in Neighbourhood

Brainstorm and create innovative ways for residents to learn more about nature in your neighbourhood, such as by painting a nature mural or organising games to encourage residents to participate in nature-based activities.
